



GENERAL CARE – Floor Standing Tub Faucet

Caution: Do not, under any circumstances, use scouring agents, abrasive sponges, hydrochloric acid, i.e. so-called lime-scale removers, vinegar (acetic acid)-based cleaners, ammonia or metal silicates. In view of the multiplicity of domestic bathroom cleaners and other special purpose cleaners on the market, and the fact that their formulations are liable to change, they should not be used for cleaning our fittings. In view of the foregoing, please note that damage to surface material caused by incorrect treatment is not covered by the terms of the limited warranty.

To derive long lasting pleasure from your product and to preserve its attractive appearance, please note the following:

Water contains lime, to a greater or lesser extent, which is retained on the surface of the fitting, leaving deposits after the water has evaporated. You can prevent lime deposits from forming by always wiping the fitting dry immediately after use. This way, your fitting will always be clean. To clean the fitting, remove minor deposits by wiping with mild soap or a wet, soapy cloth, rinse off and wipe dry with a towel.
